you are kindly invited to attend the conference ***Inertial Sensors and Systems*** which will be held in Karlsruhe (Germany), 19 - 20 September 2017.

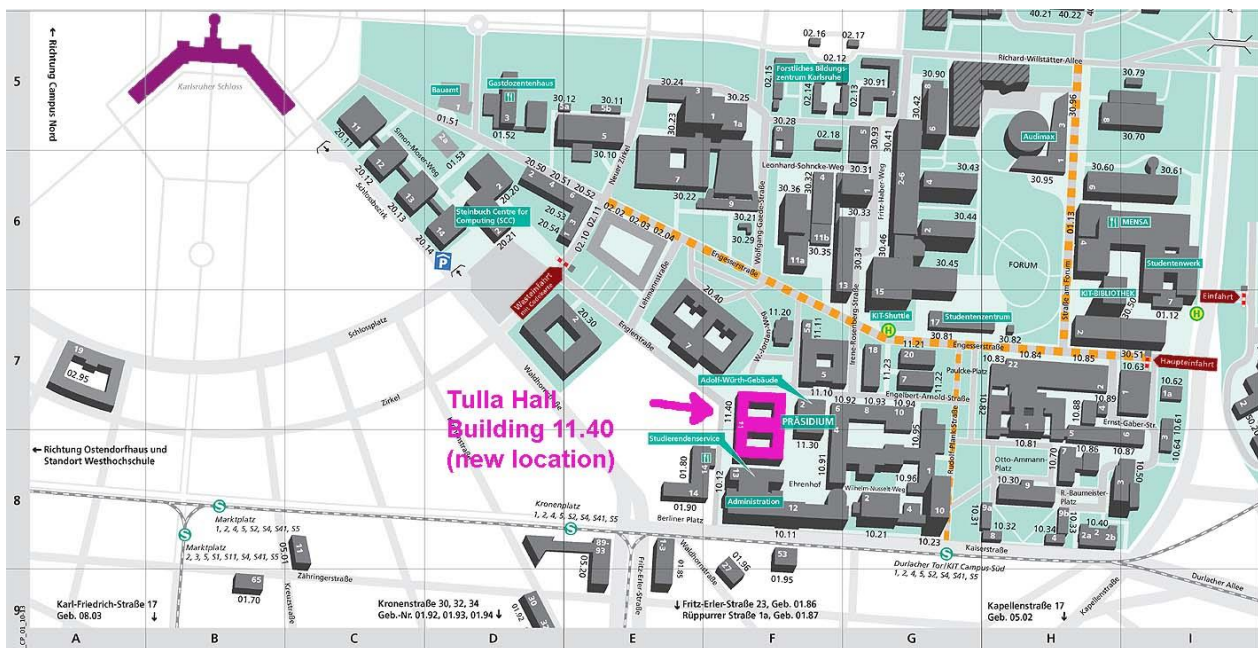
